Specific terms & conditions

These licence terms must accompany each Lenovo Do font issued for use by Lenovo.

Worldwide licence for Foundry Gridnik typeface – renamed Lenovo Do

for the client – the set includes 4 weights: Light, Regular, Medium, and Bold in OpenType Level 2 format for Mac and PC on the basis of a worldwide company multi-user licence, unlimited as to time and number of sites and use of the typefaces on an unlimited number of input engines (CPUs) and output engines within Lenovo's organization – with an extension to include external third party companies working on behalf of Lenovo

Please be aware of the following conditions. They are a requirement of the font licence and are also essential to protect Lenovo's licence investment in the font.

Lenovo have exclusive use of the Lenovo Do font set.

The fonts may only be used on Lenovo sites and only by authorized users.

No copies of the fonts may be produced for supply or use of unauthorized users, or for any purpose other than those expressly permitted in the font-software licence supplied.

The right to use The Foundry/FoundryTypes Ltd. software product Lenovo Do font is granted only on the condition that Lenovo and external third party companies working on behalf of Lenovo agree to comply with the licence conditions. Web licensing

In addition to worldwide licensing internal and external use:

Licence for website embedding of 4 weights of Lenovo Do [Foundry Gridnik]] through use of Cúfon*, or SWF as subsets within Static Flash files**, or SIFR***

Licence term: unlimited as to time

Use specific to one named domain **Lenovo.com**

Subject to the relevant licensing being in place, certain restrictions of use will be required [depending on the method of embedding] and necessary protections for the fonts ensured.

Any further urls as sub-domains of the main domain, ie they include the main domain name in them and using the same permitted method of embedding, would be covered under the above web embedding licence.

Domain names that are significantly different to the main domain will require further licensing.

Any apps will require further licensing – depending on number of apps, method of font implementation, and number of weights of the font involved.

Restrictions & protections

*Restrictions of use with Cúfon:

- obfuscated filenames to make it harder to detect them from a cursory examination of the code
- tying the font to a specific domain to prevent the fonts being directly accessed or included on other domains
- use of only a subset of character set

If applicable:

- webfont licensing information on copyright and allowed domain information embedded in the CSS

- 'Protect from import option' to be enabled when files are generated

[note -any difficulties in use of the resulting Cúfon modified or reformatted font data cannot be supported by Foundry Types Ltd]

** For use within Flash [SWF]– to embed fonts requires that where Flash files embed actual portions of a font's source code within themselves, that the text in the Flash files must be static [not dynamic]. The files must embed only a subset of the character set, the files must be 'read only', and/or configured so that they cannot be edited, modified in any way, and the 'Protect from Import' option must be enabled when the files are generated.

***sIFR (Scalable Inman Flash Replacement)

To use font with sIFR, you must ensure that the appropriate AS files are configured to prevent unauthorised users from accessing the files.

For version 2 of sIFR you must amend the 'customise_me.as' file. Set the allowed domains array to include only the domain of your website (instead of """), and then set allow local to "false" before publishing the .swf to the web. For version 3 of sIFR, these settings are within the 'Options.as' file. All Flash files should be protected from import.
